

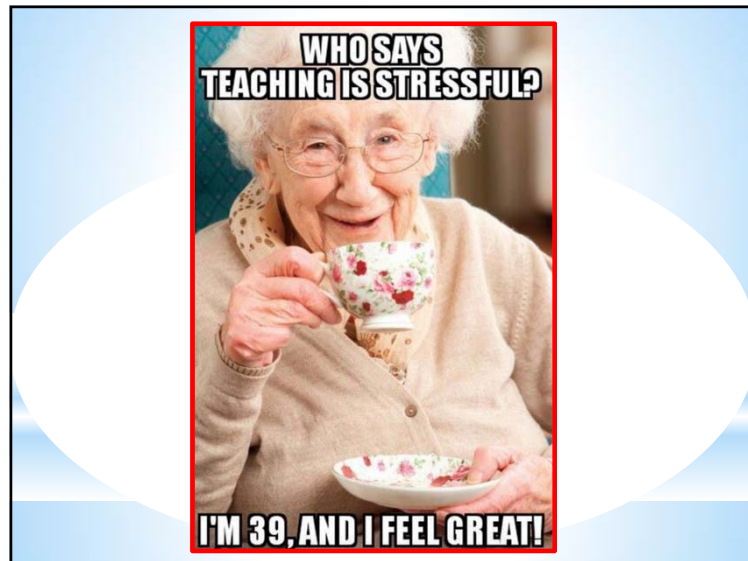


Shopping Numbers 2018-2019 School Year
