



ELPA21

English Language Proficiency Assessment for the 21st Century

- → High Stakes Assessment
- → K-6 Tested from Feb 1st to Feb 29th
- → 7-12 Tested from Feb 5th to Feb 27th
- → 4 sections: Listening Reading Writing Speaking 1-1

We have three ELPA 21 proficiency status.

Emerging: Students are emerging when **they have not attained a** level of English language skill necessary to produce, interpret, and collaborate on grade level content-related tasks in English. Students scoring Emerging on ELPA21 are eligible for ongoing program support.


Progressing: Students are progressing when, with support, they approach a level of English Language skill necessary to produce, interpret, and collaborate, on grade -level content-related academic tasks in English. Students scoring Progressing on ELPA21 are eligible for ongoing program support.

Proficient: Students are proficient when they attain a level of English language skill necessary to independently produce, interpret, collaborate, **and succeed in grade-level content-related academic tasks in English.** Once proficient on ELPA 21, students can be considered proficient/exited from program support.


