Request permission for out-of-state travel to attend the National Forensic League National Tournament in Birmingham, Alabama June 15-22, 2013 and \$300/student district funding for student travel per board policy DBL.

This is the 11th straight year our team has qualified someone to the National Tournament, sending 3 competitors this year. We have had a very successful year this year, with over 26 people competing at 2 or more tournaments, placing in the top 5 teams in team sweepstakes at over half of the meets we competed in, 3rd at State, and 2nd at the National Qualifiers. This makes it one of the largest and most successful competitive activities at North Valley. This year, they have fundraised over \$2,000 with a goal of raising another \$2,000 before the end of the year to help pay for the OSAA State and NFL Nationals tournaments. In the past, the district has funded students attending national tournaments at \$300 per head.
