Dear Parents/Guardians,

- whether the teacher has met the Oregon Department of Education's requirements for certification for the grade level and subject areas in which the teacher provides instruction;
- whether the teacher is teaching under an emergency or other provisional status through which Oregon qualifications or certification criteria have been waived;
- the college major and any graduate certification or degree held by the teacher;
- whether the student is provided services by paraprofessionals, and if so, their qualifications.


Jerome Prairie's Field of Dreams


Candle Sale Fundraiser
