Re: Illinois School Report Card

Each year, the State of Illinois publishes an interactive report card for each school and district that provides extensive information on academic progress, district and school environments, student/teacher/administrator demographics, and finances. The report card includes a Tier Designation based on the ESSA laws. The five Tiers, from highest to lowest, are Exemplary, Commendable, Targeted Support, Comprehensive Support, and Intensive Support. All three District 103 schools were rated Commendable. Because Sprague students do not take the IAR assessment, the state uses the third-grade results for the academic portion of the designation.

The designations are determined using multiple data points, including student growth in math and ELA, proficiency in math and ELA, science proficiency, English Learner proficiency, and attendance. Each area is weighted with 50% of the academic weight attributed to student growth in math and ELA and 15% to proficiency.

Included in the Report Card is the 5Essentials Survey Results. The administration has reviewed the reports for each school and set goals to target areas marked as “weak” into the goals for this year. Aside from the 5Essentials, I am researching other staff-centered surveys that can provide more tailored information regarding climate and culture.
