RE: Update on Burgess Field

Work on the Burgess Field Turf Replacement Project has begun. Nicholas and Associates broke ground on Monday, May 21, 2012 on this long awaited project. In preparation for this work, notices were sent to neighbors who live on those streets near the football field and on those feeder streets that lead to the site. The letter apprised them of the work to be done, what they might expect in terms of additional street traffic, and the estimated timeline for the project. "No Trespassing" signs were mounted on the fencing around the field. The contractor erected silt fencing to contain possible runoff and the construction entrance to the site was established. In order to protect the track, double layers of 2" thick sheets of foam board were laid around the track and gravel was poured over the foam board. The goal posts were removed from the end zones and lastly, a construction camera was installed. The camera refreshes every ten minutes allowing for an almost up-to-the-minute picture of what is going on at Burgess Field.
