



## **REQUEST FOR APPROVAL OF INNOVATIVE SERVICES FOR STUDENTS WITH AUTISM GRANT AWARD PROGRAM SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT**

This shared service agreement between Ector County ISD, Big Spring ISD and Midland ISD is to improve services for students with Autism by providing improved classroom experience, technology and training, impacting educators, parents and ultimately the targeted students in Member Districts.

This agreement allows observation in model classrooms and teacher mentoring funded by the Program and provided through the Region 18 Education Service Center and ECISD. It is a tremendous opportunity to partner with BSISD and MISD to be able to provide a variety of materials, technology and training for educators and parents. It allows us to assist students with severe forms of autism who need a variety of skills, strategies, and alternate curriculum. This partnership will affect a total of approximately 329 students among the three Member Districts combined.

This agreement will be in effect from approval of the school board for 2 years or until terminated by either party with a thirty-day written notice.
