None	 2.0120.12 Definition of At-Risk Student Any student who meets any of the following criteria is considered at-risk, and may receive appropriate interventions: Failed a high school course and is therefore credit deficient for graduation progress; Below grade level in reading (as measured on a state or LEA reading assessment); Low performance on a State or LEA assessment (meaning they score below proficient on any measure); Poverty (meaning eligible for free or reduced lunch); High mobility (meaning a student who has not been enrolled in the same school for a consecutive 160 days within the past 36 months); Limited English proficiency (as assessed on the state approved English proficiency exam); Chronic absenteeism (meaning attendance is less than 90%); and Homelessness (defined as a student who lacks a fixed, regular, and adequate nighttime residence).
