


Pre-K Mission



Enrollment Numbers




Who did DISD PreK serve in 2021-2022?



Progress Monitoring





- Assess student growth four times a year
 - ➤ Each nine weeks
- Measures early literacy and math skills and social and emotional development
- Targeted small-group instruction

Pre-K Expansion: Five Year Forecasting

- Expected to continue to grow, potential to serve ~2,400 four year olds
- Desire to offer bilingual Pre-K at every bilingual/Dual Language campus
- Hire additional instructional coaches to support staff







2022-2023 Program Goals

- Continue to support teachers with implementation of new curriculum
 - Individualized Coaching
 - Curriculum Planning Sessions
 - Book Studies- Behavior, Literacy, Math
- Input grades in Teacher Access Center (TAC)
- Increase assessment alignment and intervention services
- Provide opportunities to enroll Pre-K eligible 3-year-olds where space is available at limited locations (Available Dual Language Campuses), Gonzalez School for Young Children, and Ann Windle School for Young Children
- Continue Full Day Pre-K Expansion efforts for eligible 4-yearolds
