

# Our Why

**We believe every student, every day can succeed when instruction meets them where they are. Through flexible grouping and WIN time, we intentionally use data to provide targeted support and enrichment so all students receive what they need, close learning gaps, and continue to grow with confidence.**

## ● What is Flexible Grouping and WIN time

Flexible grouping is when students are grouped and regrouped based on assessment data to meet their individual learning needs, sometimes working with different teachers or in different rooms based on skill level.

WIN time stands for “What I Need” and is a dedicated time to close the achievement gap by meeting students where they are and providing targeted support or enrichment.




# Title Plan and Smart Goals

**SMART GOAL: All students will receive instruction targeted to their specific skill needs during WIN time, measured by teacher small group plans and data that is collected.**

Kindergarten and first-grade students will increase proficiency in early reading composite from fall 2025 to spring 2026 by 5%.


2nd-grade students will increase proficiency in the aReading composite scores from fall 2025 to spring 2026 by 10%.
