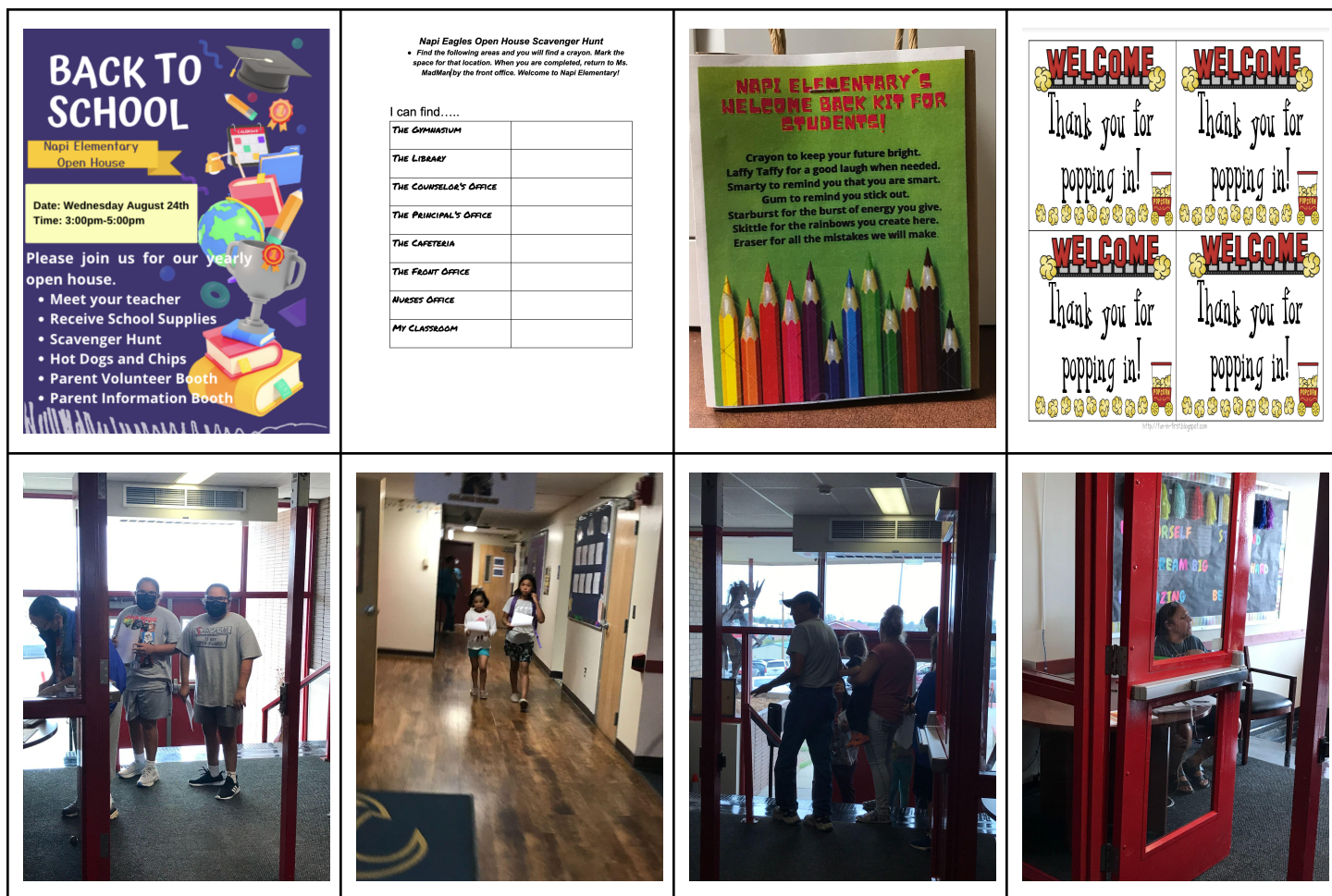

MTSS first day of school kick off assembly

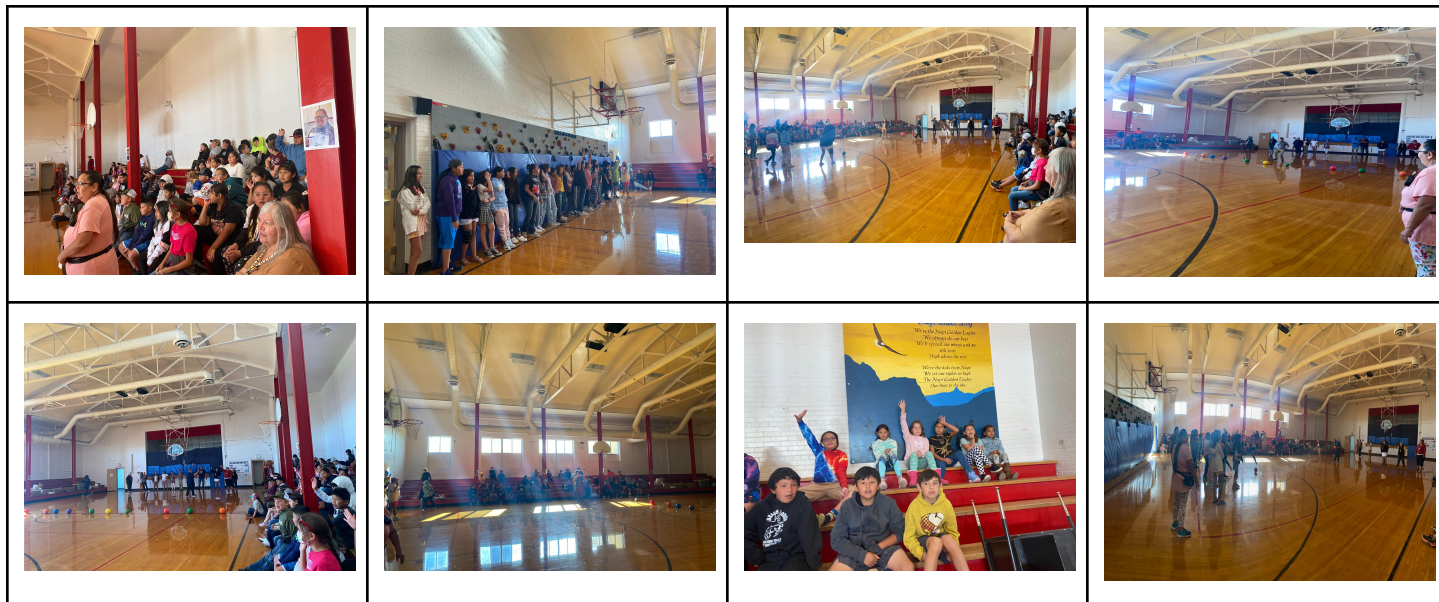
Students and staff enjoyed motivational speeches and activities, which included a pie eating contest, three legged race, egg and spoon race, and a dance contest.





First Staff Vs. Students Dodgeball Challenge

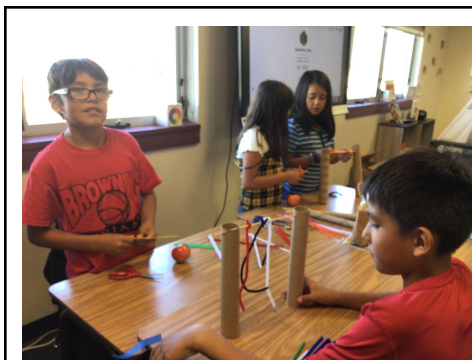

SEL (Social Emotional Learning) Daily Lessons

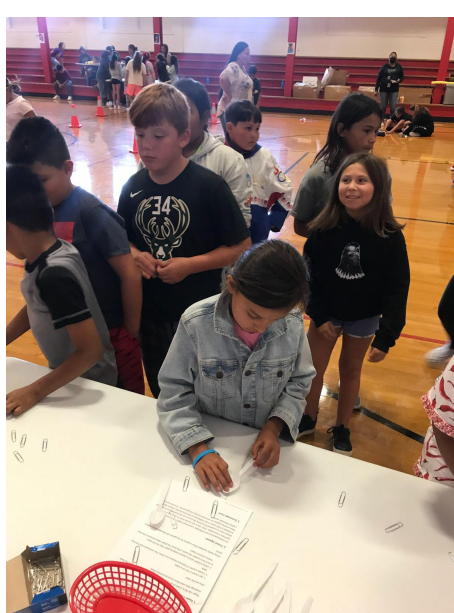
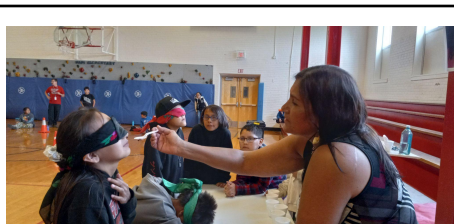
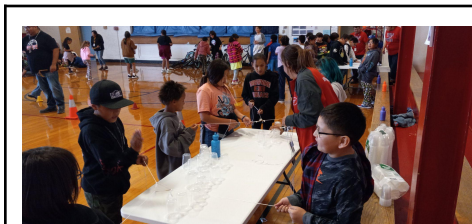
