Teaching, Learning & Relevance

- Numeracy & Literacy Goal - The Fastbridge assessment window is now closed. Numeracy and Literacy growth goals have been updated on the high school scorecard.
- Numeracy & Literacy Goal -Math and English Language Arts (ELA) departments have identified high priority student target groups to monitor in the areas of numeracy and literacy.
- Numeracy & Literacy Goal -Math and ELA departments have been continuing to learn more about Fastbridge assessments. Math has new reports that were not previously available and will be used to provide class and target group interventions.
- Student Relevance Goal - Members of the administrative team attended session one of the Redefining Ready cohort. National readiness indicators were reviewed and initial discussions focused on which indicators may be used in Tomahawk.

Communication & Community Engagement

- Communication Goal - Initial data collection system is in place to track the communication methods currently being used by the high school. General categories include: date, audience, information topic and communication method. This information will be used to assess current practices and identify improvement areas.
