STUDENT ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Who we serve — and why it matters

Summer Bridge

- 1 18 or more days of absence
- 2 10 or more days of suspension
- 3 Academic failure (E) in Math, English, Science, or Social Studies

Target: Rising 5th→6th & 8th→9th graders most at risk of falling behind during the transition year

HS Credit Recovery & MS Enrichment

Academic Need

Students who have failed core courses or are significantly behind grade level

Attendance Concerns

Students with chronic absenteeism patterns that have impacted learning

Transition Support

Rising 6th graders needing bridge support as they enter middle school

Teacher/Counselor Referral

Students recommended by building staff based on academic performance data

GOALS & EXPECTED OUTCOMES

Building momentum — keeping students on track for the year ahead



Credit Attainment

9th–11th grade students recover failed credits to stay on track for on-time graduation



Academic Acceleration

Middle school students strengthen core skills in ELA and Math before the next school year



Smooth Transitions

Rising 5th→6th and 8th→9th graders build confidence and skills for their next building



Attendance & Re-Engagement

Reconnect chronically absent students to school through structured, supportive programming



Reduce Summer Slide

Prevent learning loss over summer months for our most vulnerable student populations



On-Time Promotion

Support students in meeting promotion requirements for their current grade level

SHARED LEADERSHIP & SUPPORT

Cross-program leadership team supporting all three summer programs

The following positions are shared across all three programs (HS Credit Recovery, MS Enrichment, and Summer Bridge) and provide centralized coordination, instructional support, and student services throughout the full summer session.

Position	FTE	Days	Notes
Secondary Summer Program Supervisor	1.0 FTE	33 days	<i>Oversees all three programs</i>
Instructional Coach	1.0 FTE	33 days	<i>Supports instruction across all sites</i>
Truancy Officer	0.5 FTE	33 days	<i>Attendance monitoring & outreach</i>
SEL Coordinator	0.5 FTE	33 days	<i>Social-emotional learning support</i>
Literacy Coach (Summer Bridge)	Partial	9 days	<i>Setup, PD & preparation support</i>

Note: Security staff work 7 hours/day and do not participate in PD days or optional workdays. All other staff participate in professional development days prior to each program's start.
