 - Eden Prairie High School teacher Linda Wallenberg has been named the 2025 Minnesota Teacher of the Year! Linda was awarded the honor at a ceremony on Sunday, where she was recognized for her excellence and commitment to students. Linda was joined at the ceremony by other finalists, including Eagle Heights Spanish Immersion teacher Araceli Pastrana. "Teaching is about the journey the opportunity every fall and every single day to begin anew, to guide students along their own journeys, to build people, not just scholars," Linda said in a statement released by Education Minnesota. *Congratulations*, Linda, on a well-deserved honor!
 - The EPHS boys varsity volleyball team has won their first eight games (and counting!) of the regular season this
 spring! This is the first season that boys volleyball has been recognized as a Minnesota State High School League
 varsity sport, and EPHS is competing with a determined squad of students, many of whom might not play a varsity

 - Two staff members have recently made fantastic achievements: Dr. Quennel Cooper, Principal of Prairie View Elementary, has been elected to a two-year term as the Minnesota Elementary School Principals' Association Secretary and Treasurer. His role will be key in shaping the future of educational leadership and advocacy for Minnesota's elementary and middle-level principals. Secondly, Pathways Coordinator Ethan Dado has been named an Association for Career and Technical Education Fellow. The program recognizes and trains leaders "with a strong desire and motivation to support an educated, prepared, adaptable and competitive workforce."
 - In March, a Discovery Group of fourth graders from Prairie View Elementary learned about gravity with the help of the Eden Prairie Fire Department! Students built contraptions to prevent an egg from breaking in a fall, but the playground equipment wasn't tall enough to test their designs. His design, which blends elements from the new Minnesota state flag with SouthWest Transit's colors, will feature on buses running on the new 686 route from SouthWest Station in Eden Prairie to MSP Airport.
 - Congratulations to the EPHS DECA team for their achievements at the Minnesota State Development Career
 Conference in March! 50 competitors more than a third of the team qualified for the DECA International Career
 Development Conference.
 - 12th grade supplementary student Sameul Grogin, who takes an AP Computer Science class with EP Online, won the 2024 National Trig-Star award! Sponsored by the National Society of Professional Surveyors, the competition honors high schoolers who excel in math.
