2025 York City Band/ Choir Trip Proposal

Prior to Covid hitting the band and choir from Northome, Kelliher was on a 3 year rotation for a class trip. I would like to plan a trip for our students to travel to NYC in the spring of 2025. This trip will be for the graduating classes of 2025, 2026 and 2027.

Dates- Depart on March 29, 2025/ Return on April 4, 2025

Itinerary for the trip- I have attached a sample of the itinerary from 2019. Our trip will look similar to this.

Number of students traveling- I don't currently have a number for this yet. Once the trip is approved I will have a deeper conversation with students about the trip. However, in 2019 when the band / choir traveled they took a 54 passenger bus, had 6 chaperones (2 were Mrs. Kindem, and Mrs. Nissen) and 44 students with Northome and Kelliher together.

Cost- This is an estimated number from Good News Tour & Travel. I was told a rough estimate for 2025 would be around \$1,400. The travel agent said they begin to book a year out so I will have a more accurate dollar amount at that time.

Fundraising- Students will be fundraising by selling cookie dough. This has been a tradition for the music department. Funds that are not spent on this trip are used toward their Chanhassen Dinner Theater trip.

Transportation- We will be traveling by motorcoach and that is a part of the overall cost. In 2019 the motorcoach picked up and dropped off all students at Kelliher school.




