

Transit Curtain Installation Manual

V 1



Parts:

- 1 Transit Curtain
- 1 Ceiling Bracket
- 5 Sheet metal screws
- 10 Zip ties 8"
- 2 Zip ties 18"
- 1 Fiberglass rod
- 1 Cable Tie Mount

IMPORTANT:

Each curtain is custom cut for a particular bus model. They will not fit other models – do not attempt.

Read all the instructions through once before starting.



Step 1:

- For the IC and Blue Bird Transit Curtains the ceiling strip bracket is partially bent when you receive it.
- The strip has an adhesive back, remove the red tape, exposing the adhesive.
- Start with the end towards the window butting up to the wiring channel. It has a sticker stating which end goes towards the window.
- Line up the strip so that it is directly above the back edge of the seat. Be sure to make it parallel to the back of the seat.
- The bracket can be 6" in either direction from the top of the seat back to allow for lights or ceiling seams, etc.
- Once held by adhesive, then attach the bracket to the ceiling above the seat back with 5 sheet metal screws.
- The bracket should be flush against the wiring channel.






Step 2:

 Once the top bracket is attached, begin to attach the Transit Curtain using 8" zip ties through the ceiling strip first, then the grommets, DO NOT TIGHTEN at this time.



Step 3:

- Attach the cable tie mount to the underside of the wiring channel.
- Attach it to the Transit Curtain using 8" zip tie.
- Once all of them are loosely affixed, then pull the ties tight.





Step 4:

- Attach the lower end of the transit curtain to the underside of the seat using two 18" zip ties.
- There are 6 holes at the bottom near the fiberglass rod. Use 2 that closest fit your circumstances.
- The ties can go to the seat post or to the support bar.

Step 5:

• Wrap up. Cut all ends of the zip ties. Get some water. It is hot in that bus!
