

- Arrange for at least one emergency responder to have a tour of the facility before the activity.
- Ensure that if an AED is used, the Superintendent is informed and all appropriate forms are completed.

In accepting this charter, the following provisions stated below are agreed to by the chartered league shown upon the face of this certificate and Little League Baseball®, Incorporated.

1. Under terms of this charter, no other league will be franchised within the boundaries established for the current season.
2. The Charter Committee of Little League Baseball, Incorporated, reserves the right to revoke this charter or to suspend any of its privileges, at any time for just cause by giving written notice to the presiding officer of the league. Such revocation or suspension shall be effective immediately, subject to later review and action of the Executive Committee.
3. No use of the words Little League®, Little League Baseball®, LLB®, LL®, Little Leaguer®, Senior League Little League Baseball®, Big League Little League Baseball®, Little League Challenger Division®, or any simulation thereof, or the use of the Official Little League Emblem, shall be made other than in direct connection with the activities authorized by Little League Baseball, Incorporated. Upon revocation, suspension, or withdrawal, no further use of such words or of the Official Emblem shall be made in any form whatsoever.
4. In the event that any controversy or dissatisfaction may arise in connection with the grant, enjoyment or revocation of this charter, the Charter shall be subject to review and action by the Charter Committee. If a controversy remains thereafter, the league may request and will be granted the opportunity to meet with the Charter Committee in Williamsport. The league shall agree to accept the decision of the Charter Committee, as a result of this meeting, as final and binding.
5. "Little League," "Little League Baseball," "Senior League Little League," "Big League Little League," "Little Leaguer," "LL," "LLB," "Little League Challenger Division" and the Official Emblem are the registered trademarks and service marks of Little League Baseball, Incorporated. These marks are protected both by a Special Act of Congress and registrations with the United States Patent and Trademark Office. All rights in and to any and all marks of Little League Baseball, Incorporated are reserved.

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3. No use of the words Little League®, Little League Baseball®, LLB®, LL®, Little Leaguer®, Senior League Little League Baseball®, Big League Little League Baseball®, Little League Challenger Division®, or any simulation thereof, or the use of the Official Little League Emblem, shall be made other than in direct connection with the activities authorized by Little League Baseball, Incorporated.
