## Needs Assessment

### 15-16 updates:

- Minor changes in language
- Revised Classroom and Assistive Tech Questions (9 and 10)
  - Feedback from D101, 303, and 304 AT facilitators
- Change rating to selecting **top 3** vs. selecting 5

## Menu of Coaching

### Training and Coaching (accounts for 76% of our time):

- CHAMPS (19%)
- Autism (20%)
- FBA/BIP (35%)
- District Program Support (2%)

### Stand Alone Requests (accounts for 24% of our time):

- Individual Student Collaboration (19%)
- Professional Development: specific to district requests (5%)

Trimester review of up to date utilization

## CHAMPS Implementation 15-16 Goals

- Establishment of Routines and Procedures
- Presentation of tasks (verbally and visually)
- Ratio of interactions (3 positives to 1 negative)
- Acknowledgement of expected behavior and pre-planned responses to unexpected behavior

## Autism Implementation 15-16 Goals

- Increase the knowledge about ASD among all staff
- Increase the engagement of students with ASD with general education peers
- Increase student supports

## FBA/BIP Implementation 15-16 Goals

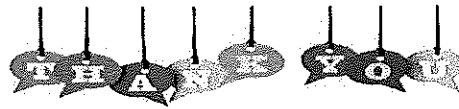
- o FBAs and BIPS that are technically adequate
- o BIPs that are linked directly to FBA
- o Establishment of a building level FBA/BIP process

## District Program Support 15-16 Goals

- o Aligned K-12 SEL Curriculum
- o Development of a K-12 behavior monitoring system

## Impact of new structure

- o Coaching
  - o Linked to training
  - o Driven by data
  - o Centered around common goals
  - o Preventative support
- o End of year assessment on coaching outcomes
- o Purposeful Utilization: Districts have received a **244%** increase in service delivery from the first trimester of last year to the first trimester of this year based on a minute to minute comparison.
