- Home contest coverage of Female and Male varsity, sub-varsity and freshman events including weekends as dictated by the Director of Athletics. Away coverage of varsity football and coverage of home off-campus events and tournaments as arranged by the A.D.
- Daily pre-practice taping and preparation as well as appropriate injury assessment.
- Treatment and record keeping including completion of all Board of Education required injury reports and insurance claim forms.
- □ Compliance with all CIAC mandated injury surveillance programs
- Provision of CIAC weight classification for High School wrestlers as required by the CIAC and the Department of Athletics.
- Coordination and provision of injury evaluations and follow up visits with team/school physician if applicable.
- □ Facilitation of visits to a specialty specific physician of the athlete's choice within 24 hours if necessary. Injury reporting and communication to the school nurse on a regular basis.
- Review of medical records and discussion and communication with coaches online regarding health, safety and participation status related to student athletes.
- Red Cross CPR and First Aide training
- Coordination/Facilitation of appropriate allied health professionals as requested by parents, coaches or athletes such as Dieticians or Certified Strength and Conditioning Coaches, (additional fees apply). If necessary, private therapy referrals will be made to facilities with in a Twenty- (20) mile radius of the High School campus.
