Minutes of Regular Meeting

The Board of Trustees Navarro Independent School District

A Regular Meeting of the Board of Trustees of Navarro Independent School District was held Monday, October 20, 2025, beginning at 6:00 PM in the Intermediate School Cafeteria, 588 Link Rd, Seguin, TX 78155.

The subjects to be discussed or considered or upon which any formal action may be taken are listed below. Items do not have to be taken in the same order as shown on this meeting notice. 3. **Call to Order**: Board Vice President, Clint Scheib, called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM and established a quorum. Present, in addition to Clint Scheib, were Dan Reinhard, Joel Frederick, and Dr. Lacey Gosch, Donna Gilliam and Becki Stephenson. Melissa Sartain was absent.

A. Announcement that this meeting has been duly called, and that notice of this meeting has been posted in accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, Section 551.043 of the Texas Government Code.

4. Recognitions:

A. National Math Stars - Navarro's National Math Stars have been recognized for being within the top 2% of scores from each elementary campus on a recent math aptitude or achievement assessment or any student who scored above the state/national 98th percentile on a recent math aptitude or achievement assessment, or any students whom teachers identify as having extraordinary math potential. Navarro Elementary has 23 students, and Navarro Intermediate has 4. There was no public participation.

6. High School Construction and Bond 2021 & 2024 Update: AG/CM Project Managers, Melisa Nu'u and Ryan Zwicke - The scope breakdown for the Elementary and Intermediate refresh that was received is being refined with the help of LPA. The schematic design should be presented at the December or January board meeting. The Chiller and Jr High School projects are under contract, working on mobilization and logistics plans are still on target to start in January. Navarro South Elementary bid documents are out for bidders to receive and use to submit their proposals. The subcontractor pre-proposal conference was held last Tuesday, October 14. Addendum Number 01 was issued on Tuesday as well. Proposals are due to Bartlett Cocke on November 5th by 2:00 PM. Bartlett Cocke will then evaluate all proposals and compile for their GMP submission for Board approval on December 15th. The Drives, Parking and Playground project in substantial completion and final punch list phase. The Athletics project is moving quickly. GVEC has finished overhead service. The turf crews at the baseball and softball fields have installed drainage pipes, electrical conduit, liners and gravel, and are working on fencing. The masons are working on the dugouts, and there was a foundation pour at the Visitors Amenities building, and CMU walls are going up. The Tennis area is to grade, with site fencing in progress. The fieldhouse building pad is to grade and the team is preparing to drill piers. Site drainage and utility work continues. The High School project is well into the final stages. Project details such as the theater with curtains, sealing shop floors, final landscaping and irrigation are being completed. Signage is also up on Hwy 123. Training schedules are being finalized for the operations team, programming fire alarms, elevators, theater lighting and the move and furniture installation schedules. The traffic signal has been at a standstill for about 2 weeks; the installer is waiting on the programming of equipment from TxDot.

7. Action Items:

A. Consider Authorization of Superintendent to Approve Change Orders for New Athletics Project, Navarro South Elementary, the Navarro Elementary Refresh (Early Childhood Center), Navarro Intermediate Refresh (Navarro Elementary), and Junior High Refresh (Former Navarro High School) Construction Not to Exceed \$200,000 per Item - Discussion included the addition of the existing High School Chiller Replacement as part of the change order approvals.

Dan Reinhard motioned to approve authorization for the Superintendent to approve Change Orders for the New Athletics Project, Navarro South Elementary, Navarro Elementary Refresh (Early Childhood Center), Navarro Intermediate Refresh (Navarro Elementary), Junior High Refresh (Former Navarro High School) Construction, and the existing High School Chiller Replacement not to exceed \$200,000 per item. Donna Gilliam seconded the motion. Vote 6-0; motion carried. FOR: C. Scheib, D. Reinhard, J. Frederick, L. Gosch, D. Gilliam, B. Stephenson.

B. Consider and take Possible Action to Approve the Adoption of the Prevailing Wage Rate, including Additional Rate(s) for Specific Trades for Construction Projects for the 2025-2026 School Year - Navarro ISD has previously adopted the Prevailing Wage Rates (PWR) in the federal Davis-Bacon Wage Determinations for Guadalupe County. Unfortunately, those rates exclude certain trades including Electrician Helper. At this time, the district needs to establish and adopt a PWR for this trade for the 2024 and 2025 Bond Construction Projects. A contractor has inquired about the rates for these positions, but the Department of Labor does not provide rates for these categories. The Administration did its own review, and proposes the Board adopt the proposed rate separately for this category along with the Prevailing Wage Rates in the federal Davis-Bacon Wage Determinations for Guadalupe County.

Dan Reinhard motioned to approve the adoption of the Davis Bacon Prevailing Wage Rate for Guadalupe County, Texas and the additional rate for electrical helper as presented by Administration for 2025 Bond Construction Project(s) and other construction projects for the 2025-2026 school year. Joel Frederick seconded the motion. Vote 6-0; motion carried. FOR: C. Scheib, D. Reinhard, J. Frederick, L. Gosch, D. Gilliam, B. Stephenson.
