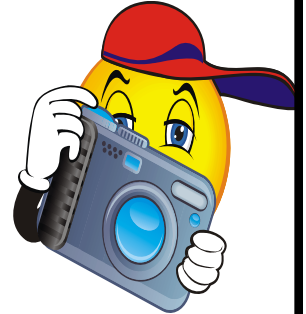
## PICTURE DAY—SEPTEMBER 8th THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL!
