BACKGROUND:

The use of Purchasing Cooperatives supports the district in procuring goods and services when issuing formal solicitations may not be practical due to time constraints or emergency needs. Cooperative contracts also offer the advantage of volume pricing, which can result in cost savings compared to issuing separate solicitations. This reflects how cooperative purchasing not only saves time and resources, but it also provides financial return that can be reinvested into our district. These cooperatives do not charge a fee to participate in the rebate program. Please note that federal funded purchases must receive their rebates back into their funds.
