MN Statute 465.03 (Gifts to Municipalities) states:

"Any city, county, school district or town may accept a grant or devise of real or personal property and maintain such property for the benefit of its citizens in accordance with the terms prescribed by the donor. Nothing herein shall authorize such acceptance or use for religious or sectarian purposes. Every such acceptance shall be by resolution of the governing body adopted by a two-thirds majority of its members, expressing such terms in full."

THEREFORE, The Director of Grants and Special Projects recommends the following resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of Independent School District No. 622 that the school board accepts the following grants, any awarded funds, and permits their use as designated by the awarding documents.

1. 2025 School Bus Stop Arm Camera grant - District Transportation

Amount: \$136,670.68

Purpose: Funding from the DPS Office of Traffic Safety enables ISD 622 Transportation to purchase and install school bus stop-signal arm camera systems on 36 district vehicles in addition to upgrading existing bus camera systems to handle the additional camera. This summer, working in collaboration with local police departments and the State Patrol we will launch a public outreach campaign to educate drivers about why they must stop for school buses and how the new cameras will capture violations.
