B. Discussion Items

1. Transdev Fleet Services

Superintendent Shaw and Karin Maurice from Transdev presented details to the Board on the proposed new fleet services contract. The proposed contract shifts away from flat monthly billing to actual labor usage, which could potentially create significant savings for the District annually. Board Members asked several clarifying questions, including the financial impact of state bus inspections and overtime costs, the district's ability to accommodate additional technicians if needed, and the reasoning behind structuring the agreement as a three-year contract instead of renewing annually. The discussion emphasized balancing cost savings, and service reliability. The contract will be presented to the Board for a vote during the regular Board Meeting this evening.

2. PBIS Student Discipline Presentation

Jackie Lenderman and Andrew Hoppert, PBIS Coordinators, provided the Board with a second review of the district's PBIS data for the 2024/2025 school year, highlighting the 15.7% reduction in suspension days over the past year and ongoing efforts to address behaviors earlier through Kickboard and restorative practices. Board Members raised questions about the percentage change in suspensions and expulsions over the last three years, the classification of behaviors such as "moderate physical contact," and the district's incorporation of social-emotional learning within PBIS. Administrators clarified that discretion, IEP considerations, and building-level practices contribute to differences in outcomes and emphasized the importance of consistent data collection and continued work on building relationships and the use of restorative practices.
