Background:

Schools in District 34 create a plan on a page with action steps each year. AUGS is currently working on the Title I 1003(a) Grant to help address the state designation of “underperforming” in the subgroup of multiracial.

Analysis:

The administration and building leadership team at AUGS partnered with Shay McCorkle from the Lake County Regional Office of Education to complete the grant application. The grant application includes completing a quality framework and school improvement report. Our current plan on the page needs to be board approved before we can submit the school improvement report. The school improvement plan includes updated goals and action steps for writing, math and social emotional needs of the students at AUGS. The 2020-21 plan on the page will include goals and action steps for reading, writing, math, social emotional and community engagement.

The AUGS administration and building leadership team met to develop the proposed 2019-2020 plan on a page and action steps in the fall of 2019.

Recommendation/Motion:

It is recommended that the BOE approve the 2019-2020 AUGS plan on the page to allow for the approval of the school improvement plan for the 1003(a) grant.

SMART GOALS

SMART Goal 1

By Spring of 2020, 70% of 6th grade, 65% of 7th grade and 60% of 8th grade students will show at least one point of RIT growth on their NWEA MAP Reading Assessment (Fall '19 - Spring '20).

SMART Goal 2

By Spring of 2020, 60% of students will meet or exceed their personal growth target on the NWEA MAP Math Assessment.

SMART Goal 3

By May 2020, Antioch Upper Grade School will decrease the percentage of students who report having a negative sense of social-emotional security by 8%.

SMART Goal 4

By June 2020, Antioch Upper Grade School will host 5 or more Parent/Student Nights. Three nights related to core curricula and two related to social-emotional supports.

SMART Goal 5

By the Spring of 2020, the proficiency level of AUGS students writing a one paragraph response will increase by 10%.
