Parent Surveys

The parent surveys were launched the week of October 31 and were available until December . During teacher conferences, parents were encouraged to go to the computer labs to complete the survey. Principals also sent out flyers in the three week progress reports as well as in the six week progress reports requesting participation. Several requests were sent by the principals via bulk email as well. The district issued facebook announcements, and the survey was featured on the district website. Within that time, we had 272 total responses. Brockett Elementary had 99 responses, Monaco Elementary had 77 responses, Aubrey Middle School had 58 responses, and Aubrey High School had 38 total responses.

Results:

Overall, most parents (87%) were very satisfied or satisfied with our schools. Parents were very complimentary about teacher and education quality, as well as friendliness of the staff. Overall, the survey showed improvement in parent satisfaction with the district website (84%), but still showed needed improvement in individual teacher pages. Furthermore, 96% of parents reported that students felt safe in school.

Trends that targeted areas of improvement at all campuses were in general communication, teacher websites, as well as other district communication accurate and updated.
