- We continue to collect for the **Pana Christmas Food Baskets** through 12/19/18 and hope to collect enough to contribute to several baskets.

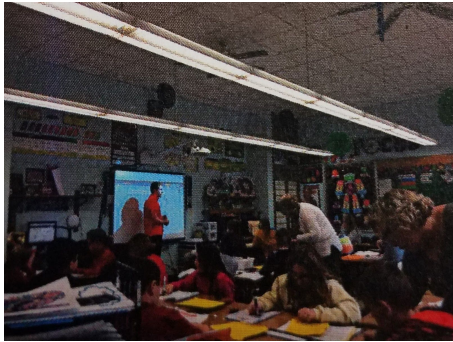
