Jeff Alexander, Assistant Superintendent reports on the following:

There was a total of 148 suspensions for the 2024-25 school year. We had 23 students that were repeat offenders:

1. One student had 8
2. One student had 5
3. One student had 4
4. Six students had 3
5. Fourteen students had 2

Listed below are the major offenses and the number of times for that offense.

1. Vaping or smoking – 36 offenses
2. Fighting or hitting – 35 offenses
3. Swearing at a teacher – 15 offenses
4. Insubordination – 11 offenses
5. Hitting, shoving or threatening a teacher – 7 offenses
6. Bullying/Racial Slur – 6 offenses
7. Leaving school without permission – 5 offenses
8. Causing a fight – 4 offenses
9. Inappropriate touching – 3 offenses
10. Other offense include: Stealing, Drugs, threatening, vandalism, and others.
