

### 2016-2017 Police Services

This plan allows for flexibility of police personnel to be utilized at the high school, middle schools, elementary schools and athletic events.

- •High School (4) –Four officers will be placed at different strategic locations throughout the campus to monitor criminal activity to ensure students and staff are safe. Officers will assist school administration with students arriving to campus, passing periods, lunches, and after school release.
- •Middle Schools (8) –An additional officer will be assigned at each middle school. These two officers will assist school administration with students arriving to campus, passing periods, lunches and after school release. In addition, the two officers at the middle school may have staggering shifts on special event days at the campus to cover school events without accruing overtime cost to the district.
- •Elementary Schools (5)- One officer will be assigned to two elementary schools daily and will provide police services consistently on a daily basis.
- •Alternative School (1) One officer will be assigned to the alternative school to provide police services to make sure the students and staff are safe.
- •Patrol (2) 2 officers and 2 public service officers will provide police services after school hours and overnight shift. The overnight shift officers will conduct foot patrols of all district facilities in efforts to prevent burglaries and vandalism from occurring to district facilities.
