

## Priest River Jr./Sr. High School Board Meeting Report November 2025

#### **Academics**

- 382 students are currently enrolled
- 51 students are enrolled in IDLA.
- The Building Leadership team is finalizing the master schedule for the second semester.
- As part of our PLCs, we reviewed the rough draft of the updated course catalog.
- The administration and counseling team will meet with students to begin scheduling for the second semester after Christmas Break.
- Due to the amount of bullying happening at PRLHS, the Counselor has developed and implemented lesson plans about bullying.
- Implementation of the Sources of Strength Program is desired at PRLHS. This is a strength based character development program.
- The Math Department completed grading the ISAT interim assessments, and the data is attached.
- The Social Studies Department is preparing students to take the citizenship test for their graduation requirements.
- The English Department is refining the Senior Project requirements and monitoring senior progress
- Student and business surveys show strong support for the establishment of an FFA Chapter at Priest River.
- The Fire Science teacher met with their Technical Advisory Committee, and received approval for the new textbooks.
- The Humanities department hosted the Christmas Concert with a combination of new and traditional songs performed by the choir and bands, and supported by student artwork.
- Teachers are meeting weekly by department and monthly in specific grade-level cohorts to develop proficiency scales and common formative assessments.

#### **Celebrations from the Month**

- The CTE Department was awarded 2 grants; an Idaho Career Ready Students Micro-Grant for \$50,000 to pay for updated ventilation, a new plasma cutting table and other supplies, and a \$25,000 Idaho Quality Program Standards Agricultural Education Program Start-Up Grant to fund new equipment for the Forestry Program, which includes a log splitter, safety gear, and the establishment of the FFA Chapter.
- The Leadership class is selling Candy Cane Grams to be delivered December 18th. In November, They raised \$396 for Thanksgiving Turkeys, and collected 279 items to be delivered to the local food bank.
