- **Moving Forward** - Transition, Ages 18-22
- **Brookside Academy** - Federal Level IV Setting, K-12
- **Riverside Academy** - Alternative Ed, 7-12 and beyond

Other Services

- High School Credit Recovery- Night/Summer
- Targeted Services- Year round grades k-8
- Extended School Year- Special Education



Extended Day Services: Riverside Academy

- **Targeted Services- K-8**
***Limited Partnership with Ogilvie Public Schools**
- **Credit Recovery- 9-12**
***Night School**
***Summer School**
-Also serves surrounding School Districts



Credit Recovery- Night School

Who and how do we service of students

- High School Students ages 16 and older
- Held at CIHS, two nights a weeks after school
- 15 hours with an instructor and 55 independent study work
- CIHS staff in licensed areas provide instruction
- All required classes can be completed
- Several non-district students attend-Rush City, St. Francis, Braham
- 77 credits were earned/recovered last school year.



Credit Recovery- Summer School

Who and how do we service of students

- High School Students ages 16 and older
- Held at Riverside- June and July- 3 days a week
- Coordinate with CIHS Credit Completion
- 15 hours with an instructor and 55 independent study work
- CIHS staff in licensed areas provide instruction
- All required classes can be completed
- Several non-district students attend-Rush City, St. Francis, Braham
- 99 credits were earned/recovered last school year.



Targeted Services

Funding for Targeted Services

- ADM per student is roughly \$7,000
- Students who qualify for TS can get an extra .2 of ADM
- Roughly an extra \$1,400 per year, per student
- 90% of this goes to staffing/teachers
- 10% towards supplies and summer transportation



Targeted Services

Who and how do we service of students

- Grades k-8-at local school sites. November-April-Tuesday/Thursdays.
- Staffing is 100% in our schools' which staff work in
- 1:15 ratio maxim, but often lower
- Students “at risk academically or below grade level”-MAP/MCA Data
- Referrals come from teachers- PLC's and SAT
- Each student is required to have a CLP
- Service around 300 students in the school year & 300 in the summer. This is a three to four week program.




Targeted Services
