Schools around the nation are invited to participate in the project by submitting their students' most creative poetry. A panel of educators reviews the poetry submitted and selects poems to be published based on a list of literary criteria). The authors of poems selected are notified individually and written parental permission is required to print their poetry. The purpose of the National Schools Project is to encourage student writing and provide an audience for student poetry. *We want kids excited about writing.*

Taking in mind the student's **age** and **grade level**, the overall quality of the poem is determined by the following criteria:

- Creativity
- Age-appropriate language
- Sensory/figurative images
- Structure
- Poetic techniques
