CREATE

Students create a tangible representation for their chosen research question. Representations can include a product that solves a problem or a simple display that depicts what they have learned during the project.



BRAINSTORM

Students take time to ponder topics of interest. They consider questions like "What do I want to learn about?" and "Are there any problems that I want to solve?" The emphasis of the project is critical thought and analysis.

RESEARCH



Students develop a plan to gather information on their chosen research question. They also compile a list of supplies and source the items required for the creating stage of the project. Students delve into the available information concerning their chosen topic using online and print sources.
