**Lead in Water - \$15,000 – Continue to replacing old water fountains.**


# K-12 Education Funding

Lawmakers have passed an *omnibus K-12 education funding bill* for the 2026-27 biennium, which includes modest increases in per-pupil funding linked to inflation and avoids significant classroom cuts for now.

However, the budget plan also includes future general education funding reductions (\$420 million in 2028-29) and cuts to specific programs such as special education transportation, teacher pipeline programs, and school library aid. The district is watching long-term impacts closely.

The education finance legislation preserved inflation indexing for the basic formula aid and *universal school meal funding*—helping local schools plan with some financial stability.
