Mitigation Activities:

- Isolation of cases
- Quarantine/Test to stay close contacts (outbreak testing should cover TTS as well)
- Outbreak testing, twice a week for all students in the classroom for 14 days until there are no new cases
 - Fully vaccinated students are recommended to test, but should not be exclude if they choose not to test
 - Students who tested positive in the last 90 days do not need to be tested unless they are symptomatic
 - Students can choose to quarantine for 10 days in lieu of testing
- Everyone must be masked in the classroom, no mask exemptions
- Have room cleaned and disinfected.
- Continue to monitor class for additional cases with symptoms.
