- Courtney and Christy attended all the high school awards programs to recognize outstanding achievement for dual credit students.
- Christy attended Hartley P-Tech end of the year meeting. Hartley P-Tech was highly successful this year. They had nine students graduate with their associate degree as the first group graduating within the P-Tech program.
- The Rahll Campus hosted a Water Festival on campus for all local 4<sup>th</sup> grade students.
- Assisted with a scholarship fundraiser for one of our former welding students. His parents established a scholarship in his honor for students pursuing vocational training.
- Summer registration was successful this year in each pathway area.
- Held GED Graduation on campus. We had multiple students graduate this year, however, only three chose to participate in the ceremony.
- Our campus staff received training from Borger staff regarding TSI and document tracking. It was extremely helpful.
- Assisted all the welding and diesel students in setting up email and Brightspace.
