method t	ory:  Dicy CV (LOCAL) states the Board "shall determine the project delivery / contract award to be used for each construction contract valued at or above \$50,000. To assist the Boar erintendent shall recommend the project delivery / contract award method that he or she nes provides the best value to the district."

The pavement / parking lot outside of the welding lab and band hall needs to be updated to prevent flooding and accommodate deliveries to the welding lab. The project is expected to cost over \$50,000. The Superintendent has determined a purchasing cooperative or competitive sealed proposals are the best methods to produce this service.

A CSP allows the district to hire an architect / engineer to prepare construction documents. In addition, it gives the district the flexibility to negotiate a project with the 1<sup>st</sup> ranked vendor or terminate the negotiations and move to the 2<sup>nd</sup> rank vendor. A purchasing cooperative allows the district to use a co-op vendor as services have already been competitively procured.

## G. Administrative Recommendation:

Administration recommends the Board of Trustees approve Competitive Sealed Proposal and interlocal agreement as the delivery methods for the procurement of construction services for the Robstown Early College High School Pavement Project.
