Current Enrollment and Forecast

- 4000 current active enrollments
- 915 applications in process
- 112 students on wait list

- While enrollments have slowed, we do continue to see a consistent take rate as families look for interruption free options.




Current Academic Progress

- Increase in students making a minimum of one year's growth (Star360)
 - 22% improvement YOY
- Continued assessment and remediation
 - Beginning of the Year Assessments (Star360)
 - Current completion rates without K-2 included
 - 75% overall completion to date
 - 80% completion – Reading
 - 81% completion -- Math
