

 district and state average in Language Arts


Overall Math Istation

- Decreased Percentage of Students significantly at risk September: 55% to April 37%


FSVA-A District Conversion Charter School:


- The State Board approved the District Conversion Charter School and a new LEA has been assigned.
- Virtual K-8 students are now enrolled in their own school and teachers and staff are working to develop a sense of identity and belonging that has been lost over the last 2 years.


FSVA & FSPS Grade 3 - 8: 2020-21 vs 2021-22
















