- **WHEREAS**, The Blackfeet Tribal Business Council is the duly constituted governing body within the exterior boundaries of the Blackfeet Indian Reservation, and
- **WHEREAS**, The Blackfeet Tribal Business Council has been organized to represent, develop, protect and advance the views, interests, education and resources of the Blackfeet Indian Reservation, and
- WHEREAS, The enumerated powers of The Blackfeet Tribal Business Council contained at Article VI, section 1(g)(h) and (k) of the Constitution include the management of tribal affairs in an acceptable and business-like manner, regulation of all business activities and enterprises, and the power to promulgate ordinances regulating the conduct of tribal members, and
- WHEREAS, The Blackfeet Tribal Business Council reviewed and discussed the proposed grant application by Browning Public Schools to the Shakopee Mdewakanton Sioux Community to aid in the funding and construction of a multi-sports complex on the Blackfeet Reservation; and
- **WHEREAS**, The Blackfeet Tribal Business Council believes that a multi-sport complex would help in encouraging young people to participate in healthy activities, that it will encourage the youth to stay in school by providing a safe and healthy environment, and that it will also be a potential economic benefit to the community; now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

- 1. The Blackfeet Tribal Business Council hereby authorizes Browning Public Schools, School District No. 9, to apply to the Shakopee Mdewakanton Sioux Community for a grant to help fund a multi-sports complex on the Blackfeet Reservation in the community of Browning.
- 2. The Blackfeet Tribal Business Council hereby supports and endorses the grant application of Browning Public Schools which is authorized by this Resolution.
- 3. That the Chairman or Vice-Chairman, and Secretary of the Blackfeet Tribal Business

Council are hereby authorized to sign this Resolution on behalf of the Blackfeet Tribal Business Council.
