



## Community Education Report

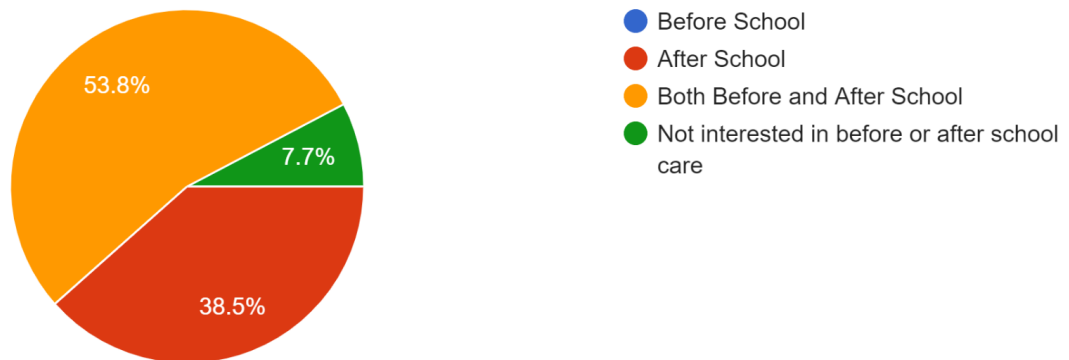

### Updates:

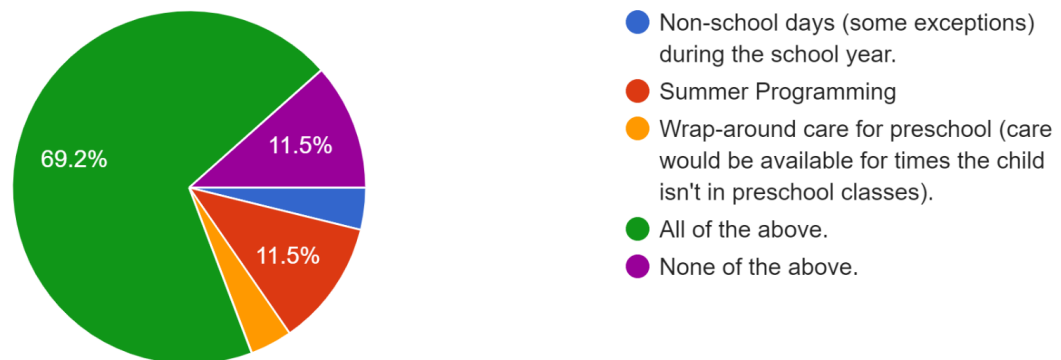
Please indicate which program you would be interested in:
