RE: NSSEO Committee Update

1. Shining Stars Update /Celebrations:

There was no shining star this month and instead we held a moment of silence in remembrance of former Miner student (D21/D214), Sophia Koval, who recently passed away.

2. Any Governance Board Meeting Items with Financial Implications to Our District

- Everything is tracking to communicated budgets
- We have yet to begin a facility needs assessment which is further delaying capital budget projects for 26-27 and beyond.
- District 23 continues to struggle with their finances and the District 211 board member expressed concerns about real or perceived economic head winds.

3. Upcoming Decisions / Votes to Watch

• We were presented with a heavily modified draft of the "Articles of Agreement," which is the document that functions as the legal agreement between the member districts, and describes the two-tier governing board structure. The document was presented by and recommended by Dr. Schnoor. The concept has the support of the member Superintendents and a likely majority of member governing board members and home districts.

4. Questions / Follow-Up Needed

- Follow up on Superintendent's contract and Director of Facilities Contract
 - Outcome: The Superintendent's contract was passed in a 7-1 vote; The Director of Facilities contract passed unanimously.

5. Additional Notes or Observations

- I will be asked to vote at the next meeting whether to advance the proposed "Articles of Agreement," along to the member districts with a supporting five minute video from Dr. Schnoor that explains the proposed changes at a high level.
- Hiring is on track to meet the needs of incoming students. Enrollment and hiring is coming in at about 98% of the projected current budget.
- The planned work on the HVAC system at Kirk and window replacements at Miner are on track to be completed before school starts.
