TOPIC: Approval of Limited Schools of Choice Program for 2015-2016

RECOMMENDATION:

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools School District accept the recommendation of the superintendent to participate in Limited Schools of Choice under Section 105 c for the 2015-16 school year. Openings to include: up to twenty (20) students at kindergarten; up to ten (10) each grade 1-2; up to five (5) students at each grade 3-4 for a total of 50 students.

RATIONALE:

Section 105c Limited Schools of Choice will bring additional revenue to the district and preserve programs essential to the students of Livonia Public Schools.
