In accordance with 35 ILCS 200/18-50, 105 ILCS 5/2-3.27 et seq, 105 ISCS 5/17-1, 105 ILCS 5/17-1.2. and Dixon Public Schools #170 Board Policy #2:20 Powers and Duties of the School Board and #4:10 Fiscal and Business Management, the Board of Education is required to approve the FY 26 budget by September 30, 2025.
