RE: Healthy, Hunger-Free Kids Act of 2010

Dear Board Members,

Section 205 of the Healthy, Hunger-Free Kids Act of 2010 issues a Paid Lunch Equity (PLE) tool for school food authorities participating in the National School Lunch Program to calculate and compare local meal rates to federal reimbursement rates. The goal of the act is for locally paid meal prices to equal the amount of federal free reimbursement amounts. For 2020-2021, the adjusted average price is the weighted average paid lunch price charged in 2019-2020, increased by a factor of *two percentage points* above the Consumer Price Index and rounded down to the nearest 5 cents. For 2019-2020 the Consumer Price Index is 2.94 percent. The Paid Lunch Equity Tool Calculated increase for Bellville ISD paid student lunch prices is five cents (\$0.05) at the primary level and five cents (\$0.05) at the secondary level. The 2020-2021 federal reimbursement rates have not been issued, the 2019-2020 reimbursement rate for lunch is \$3.41.

As required by section 205 of the Healthy, Hunger-Free Kids Act of 2010, I recommend the board increase prices as indicated:
