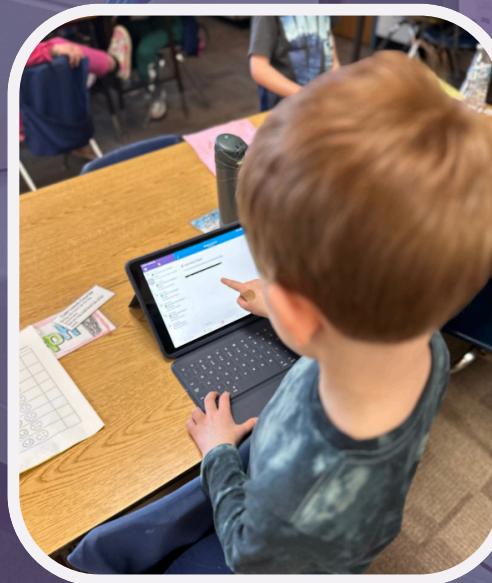

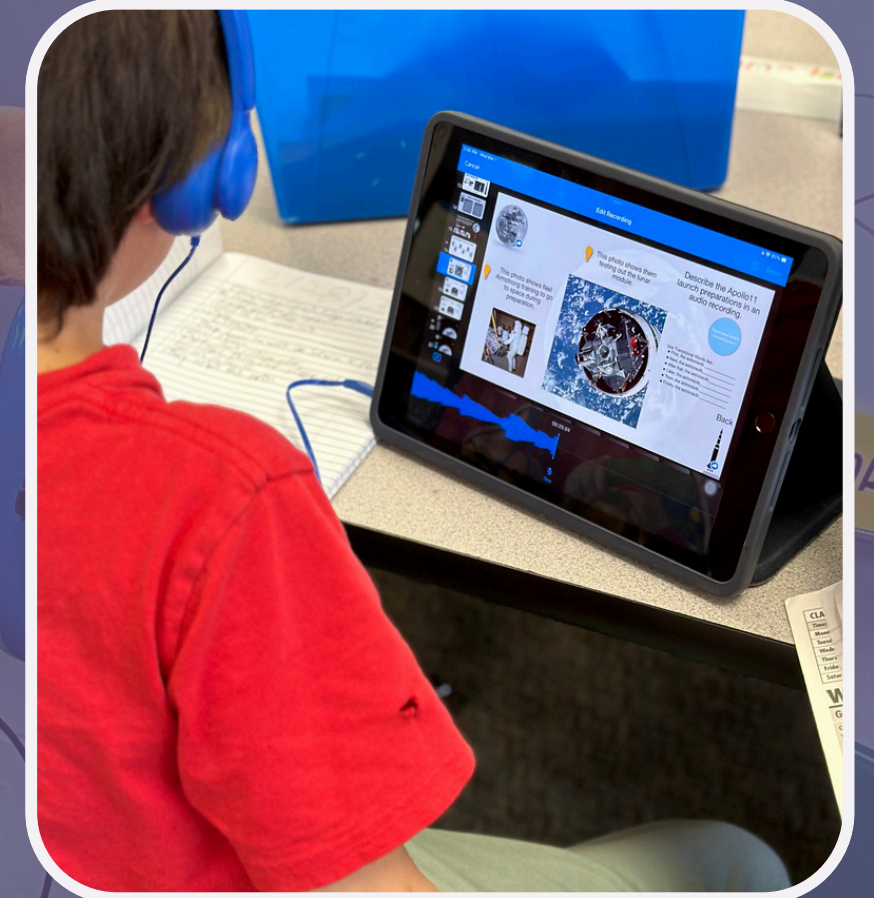

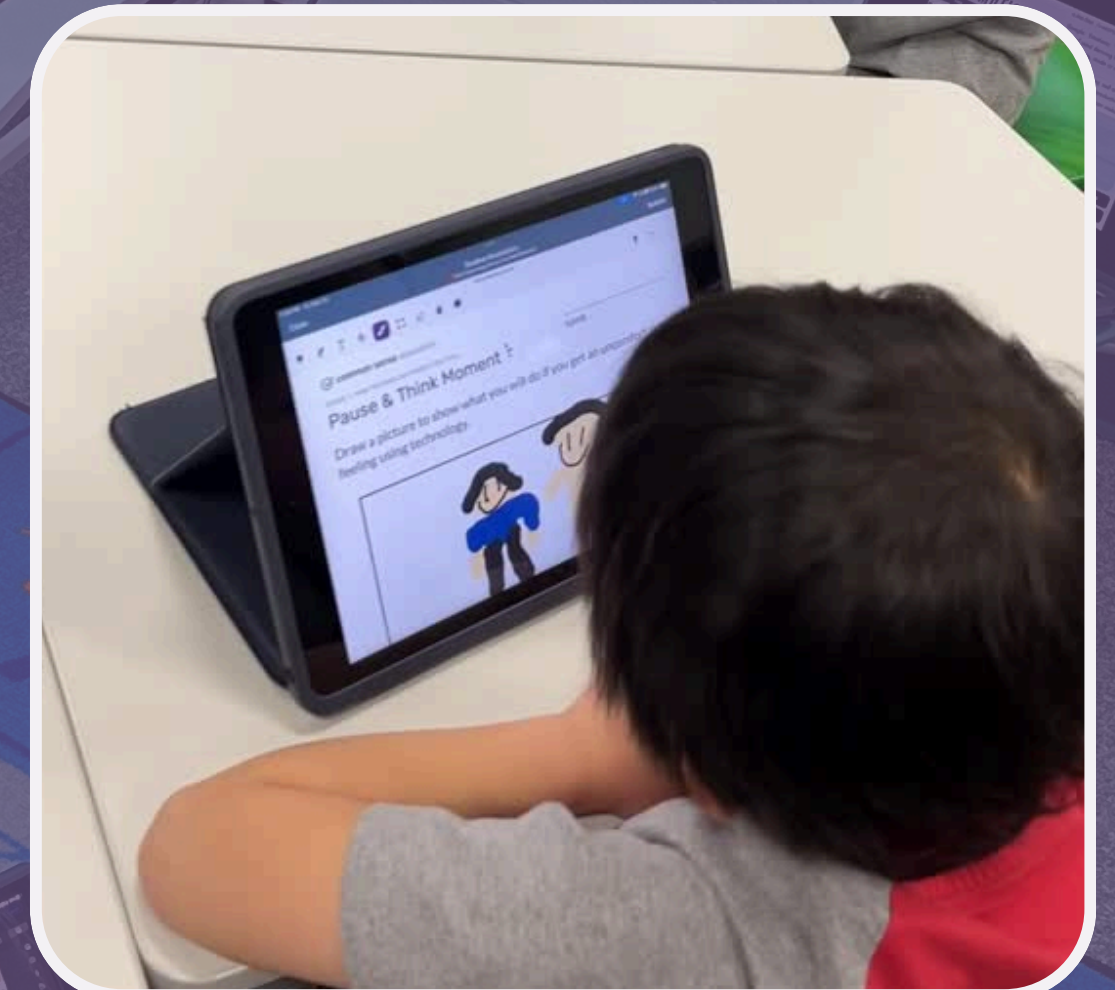

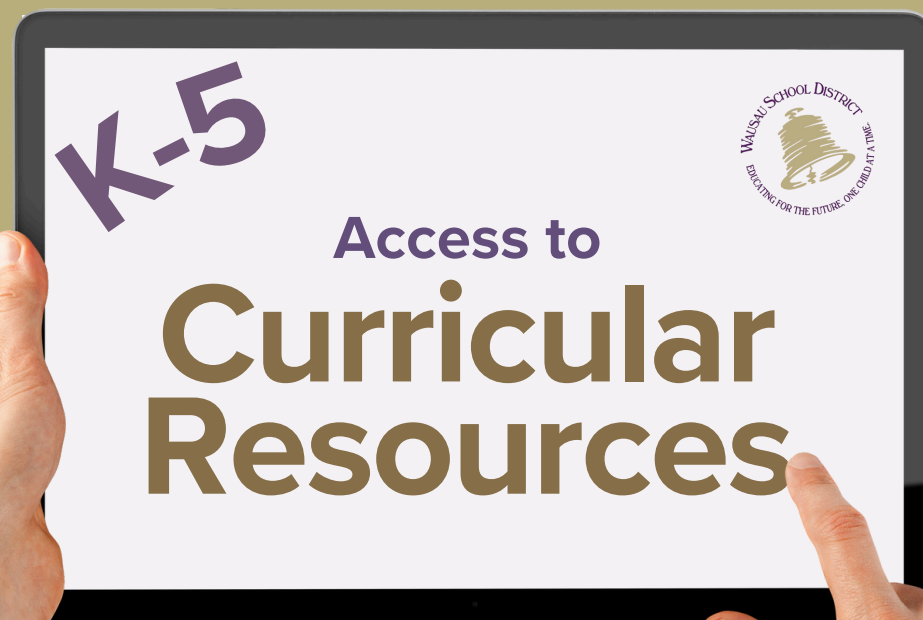

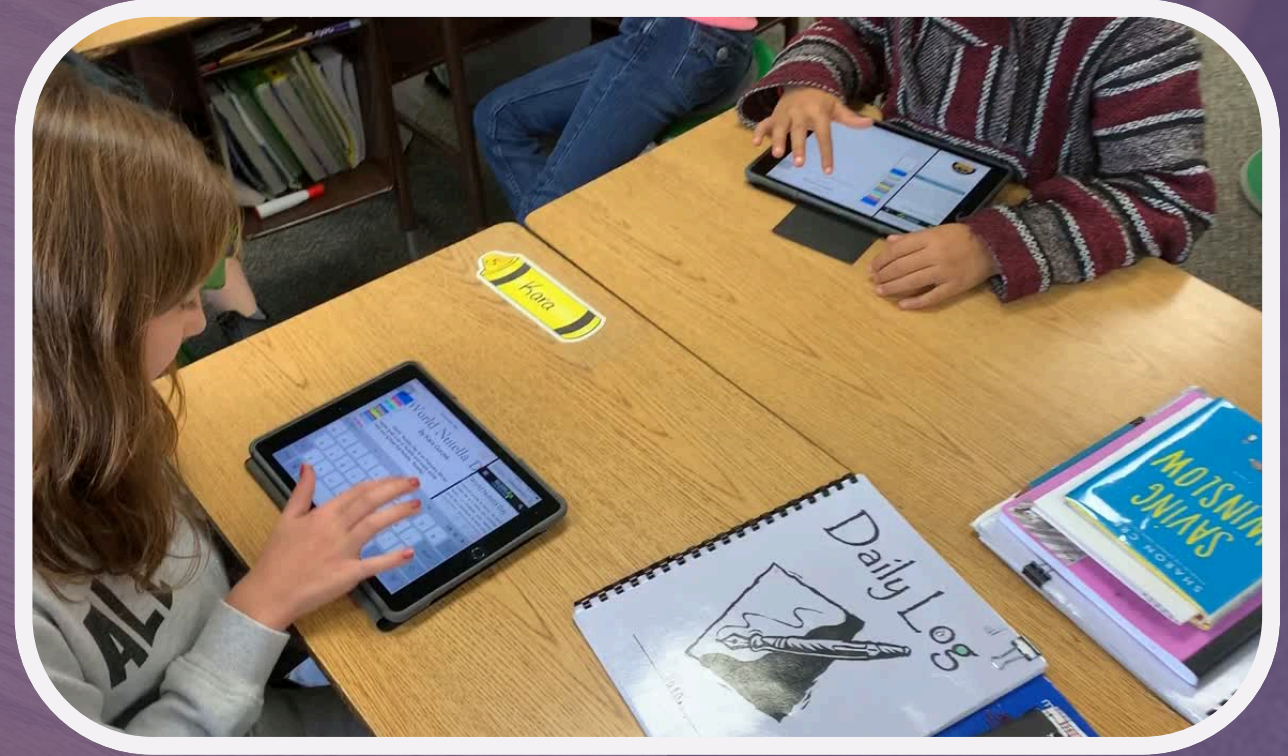

- 8th Generation, **32 GB iPads**
  - ***3 Generations Behind***
- Logitech Rugged Case with Keyboard
- Logitech Crayon (1:1 Issued)
- Built in, **Free** Accessibility Tools







# Our Challenges with Current Fleet:

- ***Storage Issues:***

- Devices unable to update without direct technical team intervention
  - Per Device Average Time: >15-40 min.
- Each iOS Update Size Increases
- Maintaining current iOS Critical to Access:
  - Apple Classroom- Classroom Mgmt.
  - State Testing
  - Curricular Resources
  - Collaboration- Teacher & Student
  - **Security:** Requires Latest iOS

## Our Challenges Cont...

- **Manually managing updates for approximately 20% of current fleet.**
  - 100 iPads per building have less than 4 GB left of storage.
  - Building Level Technical Aides (BLTAs) are on a rotating schedule.
    - Wait time for updates - when BLTA is in the building

# WITH OUR CURRENT FLEET



## PROS

Delay spending: \$250,000



## CONS

Delaying would decrease iPad value by 50% (-\$150,000)

iOS Update may not be possible

Effects will be:

- Increased IT Support @ an approximate cost of \$10,000
- Security concerns
- Resource incompatibility
  - State Testing Concerns
- Teacher frustration
- Loss of instructional time and access

\$400,000**



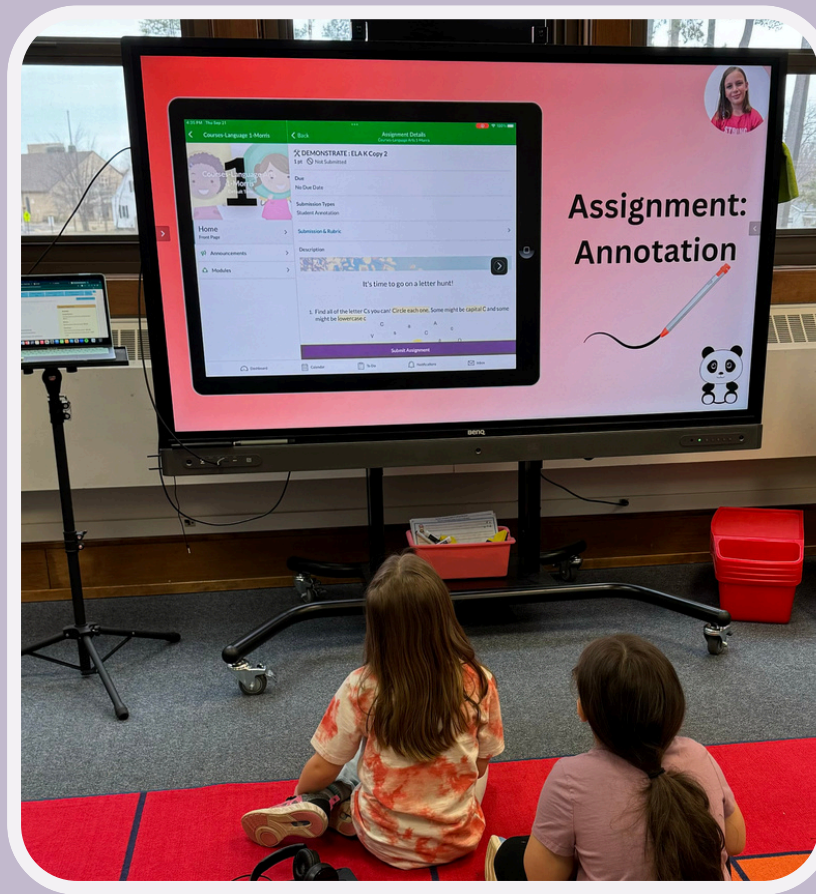


## Recommendation:
