Approve the Lone Star Governance (3) Goals as established by the Lone Star Governance Committee to increase student outcomes in reading and math performance and post-secondary readiness.
Description:
The intention of Lone Star Governance is to provide a continuous improvement model for governing teams (Board of Trustees in collaboration with their Superintendents) that choose to intensively focus on the primary objective of student outcomes. Additional expected deliverables of the Lone Star Governance:  • Distinguish between inputs, outputs and outcomes  • Effectively monitor student outcomes  • Distinguish between program/project evaluation and performance evaluation  • Understand the concepts of student outcome goals and constraints  • Effectively hold the Superintendent accountable for improving student outcomes  • Draft a Lone Star Governance implementation timeline  • Reveal Presence & Patterns  A committee of principals, board trustees, and district administrators analyzed historical trends in student performance data with regard to reading and math performance and post-secondary readiness. The Lone Star Governance Committee developed three goals to improve student achievement in reading & math while increasing student readiness and participation in college/ university, military or industry certifications.
