In accordance with the Texas Property Tax Code Section 26.04(c), the governing body shall designate an officer or employee of the school district to calculate the no-new-revenue tax rate and the voter-approval tax rate for the taxing unit as well as publish the rates.

In accordance with the Kaufman County Assessments and Collections Contract, the Tax Assessor/Collector for the Kaufman County Tax Office will prepare calculations needed to publish the No-New-Revenue Tax Rate and the Voter-Approval Tax Rate.

Tonya Tillman, Deputy Superintendent of Business and Operations shall be the designated officer or employee of the school district authorized to approve the rates and post the required notice prominently on the home page of the taxing unit's internet website in the form and content prescribed by the comptroller.
