The Mineola Marching Band Received the
BRONZE MEDAL
at State Marching Band Contest



The Mineola High School marching band received the Bronze medal November 2, 2015 at the Texas State Marching Band Contest in San Antonio. For the first time in the history of Mineola, the band qualified as one of the top 20 bands in the state to compete in the Alamodome. Following the preliminary contest with the 20 bands, Mineola was ranked 2nd overall and advanced along with 9 other bands to the finals. The 76 member band performed in final contest and was awarded the Bronze medal. Mineola ISD was rated 3rd in the State of Texas for 3A schools representing over 250 districts across the state.

On November 6th, the Mineola High School football team defeated Quitman. With that win, our Athletic Director, Joe Drennon, celebrated his 100th career win.
