Special Education

School districts have a "child find" obligation under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act ("IDEA") and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 ("Section 504"). The IDEA "child find" obligation requires schools to identify, locate, and evaluate children suspected of having a disability and needing special education services to address that disability."

Section 504 similarly imposes an obligation on schools to locate, identify, and evaluate students who are believed to be in need of accommodations or special education services.
